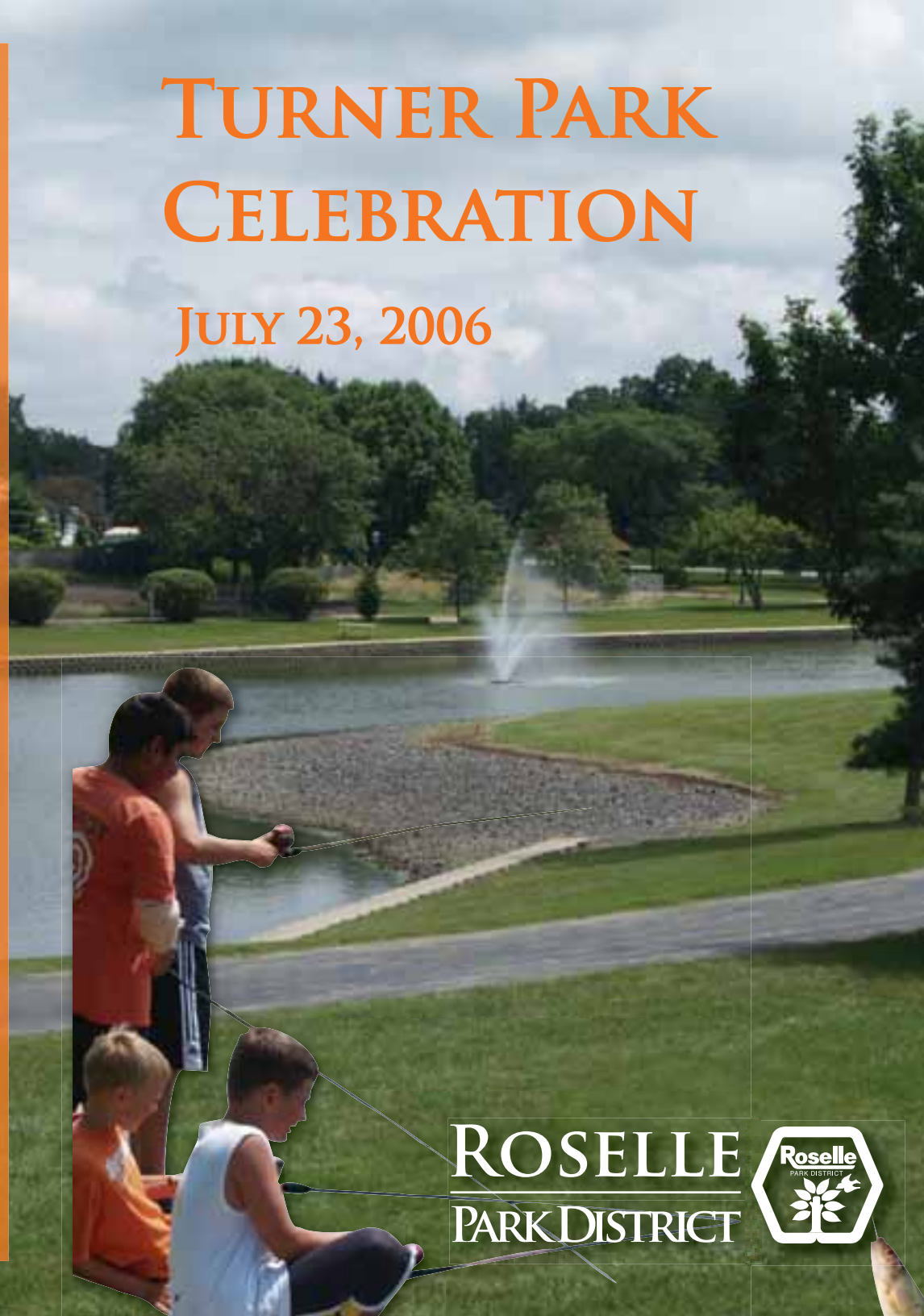
2-6 years, 7-10 years, 11-15 years, Adults 16+ years.
